

FACTS	What does Array US, Inc. (“Array”) do with your personal information?
WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
WHAT?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the products or services you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security Number, date of birth, or driver’s license number • Banking or financial account information • Transaction information such as product selections, order history, credit card number and expiration date <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
HOW?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Array chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<p>Affiliates</p>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Our affiliates include Array Plus, LLC, HelloPrivacy, LLC, and BuildCredit, LLC.</i>
<p>Nonaffiliates</p>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>If you grant us permission, we may share your information with the financial institution through which you signed up for Array's services.</i> ● <i>In order to provide the services subscribed to, we may share your information with our service providers to fulfill the services requested by you.</i>
<p>Joint marketing</p>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Array doesn't jointly market.</i>
